Main Scripture: Matthew 16:13-18 Other Scriptures: Ephesians 3:10-11

Proverbs 31:10-31 Ephesians 6:10-12

Ephesians 5:25

The word "Church" comes from the Greek word "ekklesia" which comes from two Greek words: <u>Ek</u> which means "out of" and k<u>lesia</u> – (from <u>kaleo</u>) which means "to call" or "called"

So, "Church" means – "the ones who are called out of" the world.

In Matthew 16, Jesus first uses this term. He said "I will build My Church and the gates of hell will not prevail against it."

How has your life been impacted by the Church?

Read Proverbs 31:10-31, an acrostic poem using the 22 letters of the Hebrew alphabet, describes a virtuous woman who is pleasing to her husband. Read this passage with the spiritual meaning of Christ's bride, the Church, and Jesus, the husband.

When read this way, this passage becomes an incredible inspiration and encouragement to modern Christians.

Remember, we don't just GO to Church, we ARE the Church.

And taking our cue from Jesus' words in Matthew 16, we are in a battle. Our battle is a spiritual battle (Eph 6:12).

God, in Christ, has great plans for His Church (Eph 3:10-11)
