# If needed to get a Discussion Started

- 1. Specifically, how are you applying the messages from this weekend to your life?
- 2. What from your recent personal devotions has been most meaningful to your faith?

- 1. What forms of Artificial Intelligence are you currently using in your life? What would you like to have invented or not that might make your life easier?
- 2. Read Genesis 1:26-28. From these verses, what's different for humans than for the rest of God's creation?
- 3. How would you explain to a friend this quote from the Westminster shorter catechism: "Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy Him forever." Is it true in your life?
- 4. Read Judges 2:10-12. How does our fellowship with God and one another affect our sense of morality?
- 5. Read Psalm 8:1-9. From this passage, what is our role humans in the world?
- 6. How would you answer the question: How is your soul? What could you do to make it better?
