## *If needed to get a Discussion Started*

If computers could think and feel, should people be allowed to own them? How – if at all – should people be punished for destroying such machines?

## *Applying the Word (these are 2 very important questions to answer each week)*

1. Specifically, how are you applying the messages from this weekend to your life?
2. What from your recent personal devotions has been most meaningful to your faith?

## *Hearing the Message (use some of these q's or all for your time together)*

1. What forms of Artificial Intelligence are you currently using in your life? What would you like to have – invented or not - that might make your life easier?
2. Read Genesis 1:26-28. From these verses, what's different for humans than for the rest of God's creation?
3. How would you explain to a friend this quote from the Westminster shorter catechism: "Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy Him forever." Is it true in your life?
4. Read Judges 2:10-12. How does our fellowship with God and one another affect our sense of morality?
5. Read Psalm 8:1-9. From this passage, what is our role – humans - in the world?
6. How would you answer the question: How is your soul? What could you do to make it better?
