The goal of this command is love, which comes from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith. (1 Timothy 1:5).

Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses. (1 Timothy 6:12)
