Series: TIMOTHY: A TRUE SON IN THE FAITH Message #3: DISAPPOINTMENT Scripture: Acts 18 **Other Verses:** passages from 1 & 2 Corinthians I am reminded of your sincere faith, which first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and, I am persuaded, now lives in you also. (2 Timothy 1:5). The main question we want to ask as we move through this series: "WHAT WILL IT TAKE FOR ME TO BECOME MORE U TO THE LORD IN THE WORK OF HIS KINGDOM?" "All that I am, or hope to be, I owe to my angel mother." Failure and disappointment is inevitable. The key to our future usefulness to God in the work of His Kingdom is not happens to us, but we respond to what happens to us. So, how SHOULD we respond when we experience failure and disappointment? 1. We should keep **S** Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother ... (2 Cor 1:1). **2.** We should **L**_____ into Jesus We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers and sisters, about the troubles we experienced in the province of Asia. We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired of life itself. 9 Indeed, we felt we had received the sentence of death. But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead (2 Corinthians 8:9).
