Know then that it is those of faith who are the sons of Abraham. ⁸ And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify^f the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." (Galatians 3:7-8)

Abraham was blessed

1. Because he B_____ God

"Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"—and he was called a friend of God (James 2:23).

2. Because he O_____ God.

After these things God tested Abraham and said to him, "Abraham!" And he said, "Here I am." ² He said, "Take your son, your only son Isaac, whom you love, and go to the land of Moriah, and offer him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains of which I shall tell you" (Genesis 22:1-3).

3. To be a B_____!

"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" (Matthew 28:19-20).
