must have had a *beginner*

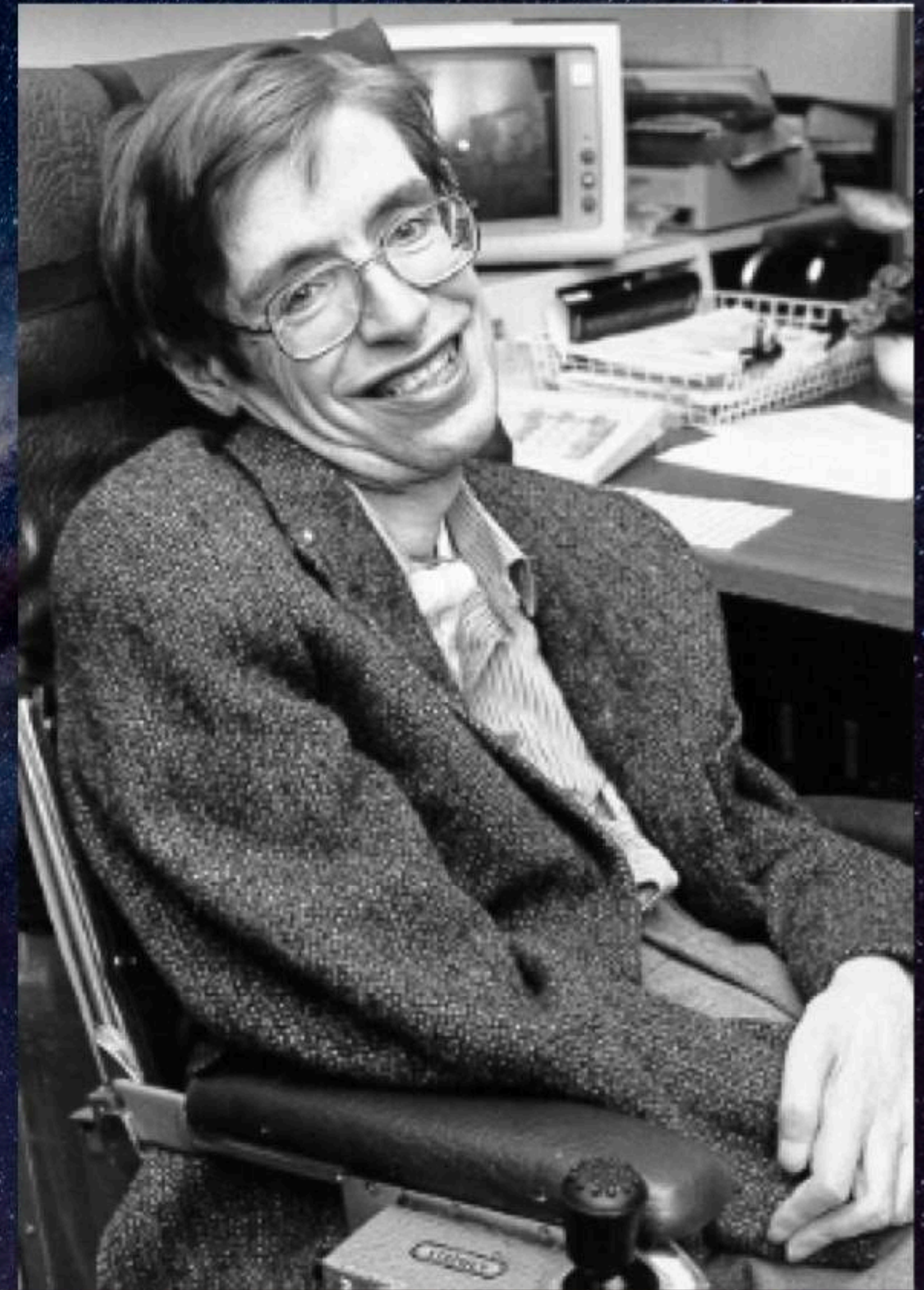

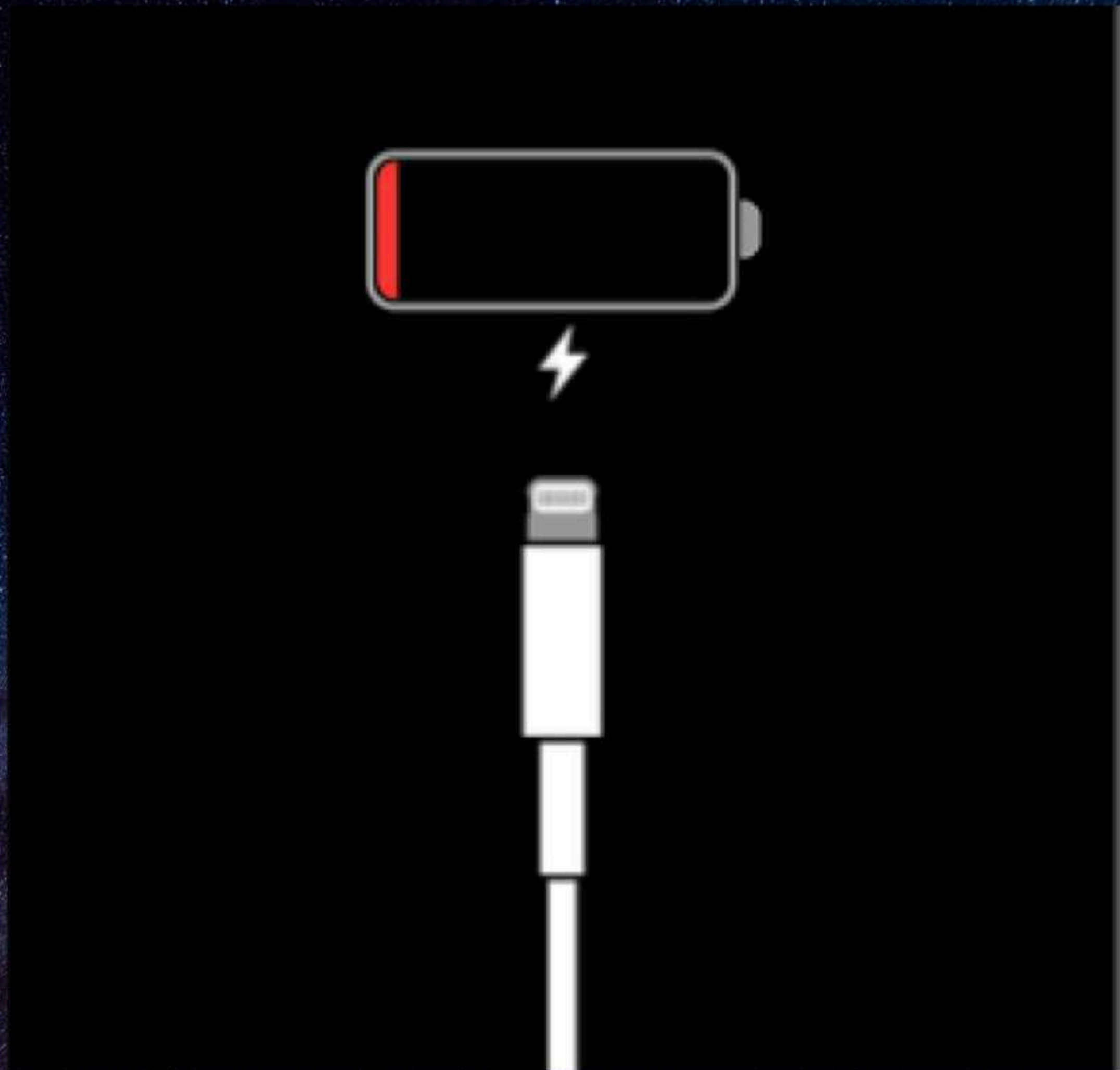

Second Law of Thermodynamics

- When energy is transferred/
transformed, more of it is wasted.
- As energy degenerates, it becomes
more disordered.

The Bottom Line

An **I N F I N I T E** being

- 1.** An infinite being lacks nothing
- 2.** For two beings to differ, one must lack something the other has.
- 3.** But a being that lacks something is not infinite.
- 4.** Therefore, there can be only one infinite being.

We are left with only 2 options

1. **No one** created something out of nothing.

OR

2. **Someone** created something out of nothing.

What does SCRIPTURE say?

1 Corinthians 2:7—We speak of God's secret wisdom, a wisdom that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory **before time began**.

Timothy 1:9—This grace was given us in Christ Jesus **before the beginning of time**.

Titus 1:2—The hope of eternal life, which God... promised **before the beginning of time**.

Jude 1:25—To the only God our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, **before all time** and now and forever. Amen.
