Job Title: Student Minister (SM)

Position Status: Regular Full-Time

Reports To: Campus Minister (CM)

Accountable To: Executive Minister

Position Summary: Gateway is one church with four locations in WV – St. Albans (GSA), Teays Valley (GTV), Beckley (GBK), and Marmet (GMT). Leading and discipling teenagers is one of the most challenging and rewarding jobs in Christian ministry and is vital to the health and growth of the church. The Student Minister serves on the Gateway staff team under the direct supervision of the Campus Minister to provide quality ministry to teens.

Expectations: The SM is expected to:

- Be a committed Christian with a willing heart, character, and lifestyle reflective of a genuine Christ-follower and ministry leader.
- ► Have a personal passion and love for God, the Church and lost people.
- Be a team player with the ability to recruit and lead a team of volunteers.
- Be self-motivated with a solid work ethic.
- Be coachable and eager to work with and learn from others.

Ministry Responsibilities:

- Oversee, coordinate and lead activities, programs, and classes of the Student Ministry area for the local campus.
- Work with the local CM to develop and manage the student ministry budget.
- Recruit, train & lead a willing and enthusiastic team of student ministry volunteers.
- Ensure that appropriate safety and security procedures are established and followed.
- Cooperate & coordinate with other GCC Ministry Staff to provide quality ministry.
- Oversee and be responsible for all areas of the local campus where student ministry takes place.
- All other duties as assigned.

Compensation & Benefits: (for detailed info, see the Staff Handbook)

- Annual salary is dependent upon education and experience, but is generally commensurate with local county schoolteachers to be distributed as desired between Housing Allowance, Retirement & Taxable Salary.
- Professional Expense allowance paid monthly in response to a submitted report with accompanying receipts.
- Vacation starting at 2 weeks (10 workdays, including 2 Sundays) 1 day added per year of service.
- Conventions & Continuing Education allowance upon request as funds are available.
